Introduction

40th Foundation Day of NCSM, Earth Day, National Technology Day, International Museum Day, World Environment Day, International Yoga Day, Children's Day, National Science Day, Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Swachhata Pakhwada, Hindi Pakhwada, International Women's Day were celebrated with student centric programmes by BITM and all its units.

A host of educational activities for making science more popular were carried out during the year. Mention may be made of Science & Technology Fairs, Summer Vacation Science Camps, Festival of Video Films, Innovation Festivals, Science Seminars, Science Drama, Popular Lectures, Sit & Draw competition, Science Demonstration Lectures, Science Shows, Taramandal Shows, and Mobile Science Exhibitions in rural Schools etc. National Science Seminar 2017 on 'Swachh Bharat: Role of Science and Technology - Promises and Challenges' was held at BITM, Kolkata. BITM and its units participated in various Mega Fairs organized by State Govt. and like minded organizations with interactive exhibits and panel exhibitions.

Various Training programmes were organized e.g., Computer Aided Learning for headmasters, fabrication of teaching aids and 'Learning with moving images' for teachers, 'Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) for Innovation Hub and Biotech Lab members at BITM, NBSC, Siliguri, Shrikrishna Science Centre Patna, DSC, Purulia, Bardhaman Science Centre etc.

In carrying out its activities during 2017-18, BITM received support from various like-minded organizations like US Consulate, Kolkata, American Centre, Kolkata, Australian National University and London Science Museum besides many NGOs in Eastern India.
